

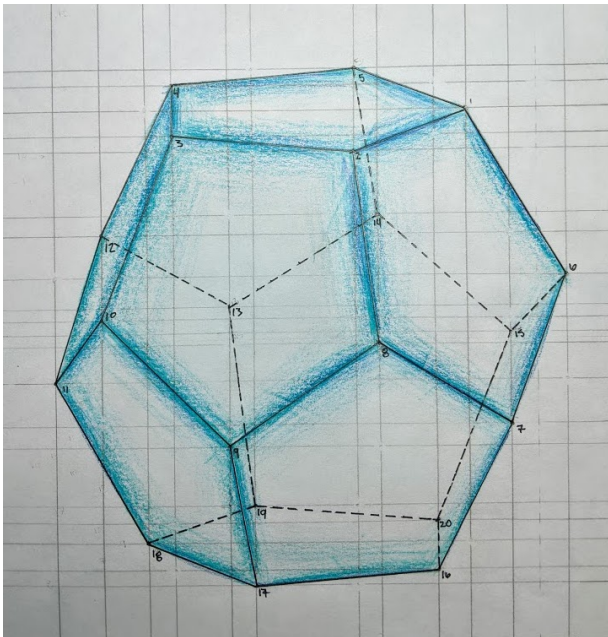


Doing Math with a Purpose in Adolescence
